Please can I remind parents to pack children a healthy snack for break time. Unfortunately this week teachers have seen numerous children eating sweets, lollies, crisps etc.

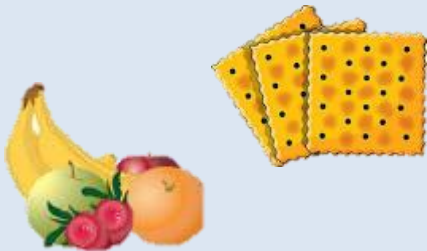

The Home School Agreement sets out the expectations for the school, parents and pupils, to ensure a shared vision.

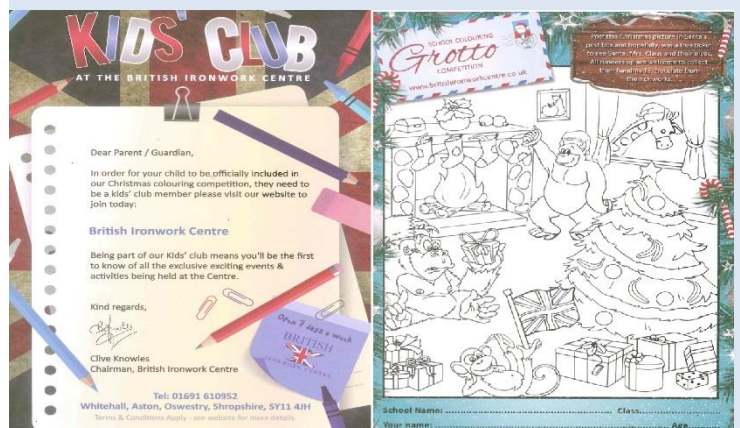
It is our expectation that all children who attend our school have a signed agreement. This is also consent for your child to appear on the website and in the local press.
