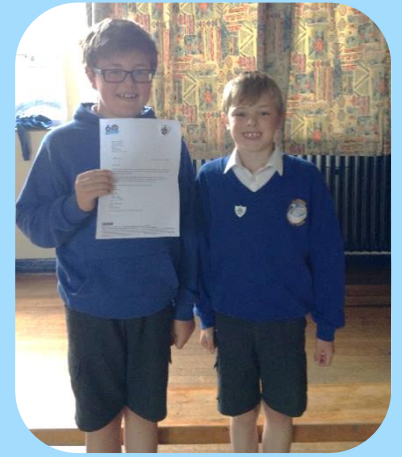
Achievements
