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Welcome back to another exciting year at Ellesmere Primary School. I hope you have all had a great Summer with your families. It was lovely to see so many happy, smiling children on their way in to their new classes this week. I am really proud of the confident and calm way in which they have all returned and settled back in to life at our lovely school.

The Summer holidays has been a busy time in school as we have begun work on improving the conditions of the school building. The school has had nearly 20 tons of ancient cast iron radiators and pipework removed and replaced with a modern, energy efficient system including new boilers to keep the children warm this winter. The Surestart Children's Centre has been removed and we are due to tarmac and reinstate the carpark at half term. There are other, more exciting improvements due to happen before Christmas, but we will keep you updated about these over the coming weeks.

On Wednesday 18th September, all parents and carers are invited to a New Class Welcome Meeting.
